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**Dear diving friends,**

I am pleased to provide you with the latest information and data for the Indonesia Trip 2022.

Travel period: 08/24/2022 ( Airport Bima, transfer to Kalimaya Dive Resort )  
03/09/2022 ( Arrival Labuan Bajo Transfer to Airport / Resort )

Together we will have 11days and10 nights for an unforgettable diving cruise ( plan see below).



This adventure will hopefully provide us with the larger marine life that inhabits these waters. Both whale sharks and manta rays are regular visitors and dont be surprised to run into large schools of hammerhead sharks. Encountering the large Mola Mola is also a possibility on this trip of a lifetime as well as many other species of shark inhabiting these waters.



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In the first part of the tour we explore West Komodo and East Sumbawa. This region is still virtually untouched by humans which allows us to experience the true natural spectacles on land as well as under water.

At the moment, to our knowledge, we are the only boat in this region on this schedule so exclusivity is guaranteed.

Since Moritz the owner of the Fenides and the Kalimaya Dive Resort in West Komodo will call upon all his local knowledge of the more intimate parts of these Islands rarely seen by any foreigners to allow you the experience of a lifetime.

The second half of the tour we spend in North, South and Central Komodo where we find Komodo National Park – as well as many other highlights underwater and on land.



In the region around Sumbawa and Pulau Kelapa we find breathtaking landscapes as well as a spectacular underwater world. This is the ideal spot for all the photographers - underwater photography, drones - flights, wonderful beaches - and here we are guaranteed to be among ourselves and probably won't meet a single other diver or tourist.

Our captain has many years of experience in the region and Moritz has built up his diving business in Komodo in 2010. In 2016, he opened the Kalimaya Dive Resort in West Komodo. He is therefore really the expert in this region of Indonesia and knows the hot spots as well as the most remote insider tips.

Our route will take us to different regions and underwater we will encounter marine life from the smallest macro critters, vibrant healthy reefs, active volcanoes (under water!), current diving, caves, cliffs, to the larger fish and other pelagics. There are many other species of sharks we can find in the waters around Komodo. Even on land, the region will not disappoint! Interesting stone formations, secluded beaches, remote typical Inonsian villages,. Then



onto the famous land creatures in these parts the Komodo Dragon shares these lands with some rare birds – you will be able to experience this and much more.

In the second half of the tour we will explore the classic Komodo National Park with you. We will take you to all the familiar highlight places – underwater as well as on land! The well-known highlights here are: Nusa Kode, Padar Island, Pink beach, Gili Lawa and of course the famous region between Siaba Island and "Batu Bolong". In the second part of the safari you will also have the opportunity to marvel at the spectacle of the "Wild Flying Foxes" at sunset, which we find around Komodo Island and Flores. But macro-lovers will also get their money's worth. Let me briefly describe the planned tour below:



#### **Tourschedule:**

**Departure in Sape with our private jetty from our Kalimaya Resort:** you land at Bima Airport where we pick you up and take you to the private pier at KalimayaDive Resort where you will start your tour on board Fenides.

#### **Saneang volcano:**

Here we dive in the black sand and if know of Lembeh then you will immediately know what to expect in macro variety. There is also an absolute highlight here: the Bubble Reef, where you can observe volcanic activity underwater. There are also beautiful coral reefs to admire. On land we visit a traditional boat builder village, hikes to sunrise/sunset and rare wild birds we will also be able to observe.

This is THE place for underwater photographers and you can't get too short on land!

#### **Gili Banta:**

A long white sandy beach and lonely places where we can admire the sunrise... Underwater there are a variety of great diving spots here: manta rays, sharks, some of the region's coral reefs. This location is also great for water sports such as our kayaks and standup paddles and a barbecue on the beach.



### **Sape channel:**

Action is called for here! Most dives are current dives where you can expect bigfish. The dive sites are located between Sumbawa and Komodo and the strömung here is definitely a bit stronger. Sharks, tuna, GT's and much more can be expected here. Big fish... this is the spot. Several times we have seen blue whales at the dive sites. So Bonus: Here's a secret cave that we can explore underwater!

### **Coconut Island aka CoconutIsland:**

Postcarddiving is the order of the day here. Crystal clear water, incredible reef typography, overhangs, walls... We dive here at Seagull Rock - one of the best diving spots in Indonesia. This spot is also ideal for a wonderful hike to the viewpoint at sunrise. Great for photographers!

### **West Komodo Coast:**

Wild. It's going wild here. Under as well as above water it is here the "Galapagos of Asia". We take you to some of the most impressive cliffs and pinnacles. On land we will visit the wild Komodo Dragon that are on the beaches. We do not announce the exact destination... we want to be alone with you here. Hence top secret. J

### **South Komodo:**

This region is also called "the end of the world", because the next stop further south would be Australia. South Komodo is magical and you never know exactly what to expect. In general, every big fish that "commutes" between Australia and Asia happens here. The water here is generally a little cooler – which attracts more manta rays and up to MolaMolas also other big fish.

### **Nusa Kode aka Horseshoe bay:**

The number of boats found in Nusa Kode has always been limited – here you will find the more abenteadstenboats thatKomodo want to explore. This little bay is a bit off-piste and often underestimated. Here we find one of the best macro diving regionsPLUS great steep walls. Here we dive at the well-known dive sites "Cannibal Rock" and "Torpedo Point" from which you may have heard before.

### **Padar Island und Central Komodo:**

This region has gained increasing popularity in recent years. If you googlt then the probability is very high that the first picture you get to watch is the photogenic landscape of Padar Island. Diving in the region is also really good. Here we dive at the spot "Batu Bolong" – one of the most famous diving spots. For good reason...



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Batu Bolog, Siaba and Tatawa, these dive sites house an insane breadth of Marine Life. Coral reefs as far as the eye is concerned, turtles, sharks and and...

### **North Komodo:**

Underwater mountains, currents and big fish await you here. In this region you will find the well-known "TripleC": The dive sites Castle Rock, Crystal Rock and Cauldron Here we also find sharks and other big fish.

### **Departure on day 11:**

After this tour, which includes all the highlights of the region (and more), Fenides Liveboard arrives at the port of Labuan Bajo. After the checkout we take the guests to their hotel in Labuan Bajo, which is Labuan Bajo Airport.

### **The boat**

All information about the "Fenides" can be found in the respective annexes. The "Fenides" was completed at the end of 2019 and came or comes relatively unscathed by the difficult year 2020 and 2021. The owners have largely concentrated on the Indonesian domestic market and have thus been able to significantly minimise the consequences of the Corona crisis.



In the enclosed annexes you will find the respective specifications, features, deck plan and cabin overview.

A special room for photo and video editing is available for our photographers. Each cabin is also equipped with a tablet to enjoy the in-flight entertainment program.

The "Fenides" is a top-class boat. From the equipment of the cabins, to the diving deck, to the crew, we will leave nothing to be desired.

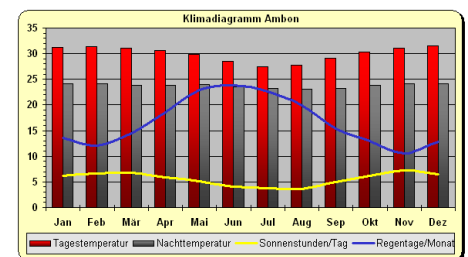


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## Information about Indonesia

Indonesia is the 4th strongest populated and at the same time the most populous Islamic country in the world. Apart from the island of Bali, Islam is also sometimes strictly practiced. Appropriate behaviour in public is required. Indonesia is spread over more than 17,500 islands, of which almost 6,050 are inhabited. It is also one of the largest rainforest areas on the planet. In addition to countless animal and plant species, the island kingdom also has a unique oceanic ecosystem. Most of all known coral species can be found here.

Entry to Indonesia is possible with a German passport ( valid for more than 6 months ) for a period of 30 days. A free visit visa is issued directly at the airport. An extension is not possible without leaving the country. The visa is free of charge.

Arrival is possible from all major German airports. However, a total travel time of 18-20 hours should be planned. Our take-off and destination cities have appropriate airports.
